

MEMORIAL COURTYARD



The induction ceremony will take place during halftime of the varsity Homecoming game against conference rival Marmion on Friday, September 20. Family, classmates and friends are invited to attend.





Hurricane Award Winners





from heaven just as she did on earth. There will be

be cheering us on. She would say to her family:
The Lord will ask you: "How much have you
loved?" We intend to reply, "As much as our mom."

Marian Central students out of respect for Kay Hansen wore bandanas to school the day after her funeral. Over 500 were collected and then hung in a display on the walls and ceilings of the English department until the end of the school year.

Transitioning to the 20'S STRATEGIC PLAN

Early in the 2012-13 school year, the Council of Administration appointed an ad hoc committee whose responsibility it was to develop a new long-range plan for the school. The Transitioning to the 20's strategic plan report developed by the committee was presented to and approved by the Council at its April meeting.
