

Semester 2 Exam Exemption for Seniors

Due to the unique challenges of the 2020-21 school year, Marian Central Catholic High School's Administrative Team decided that we will offer our Class of 2021 the opportunity to be exempt from their semester 2 Final Exams. There are certain stipulations that should be considered, however. Please review the important information below.

You **must take** the final exam if...

- You are a senior enrolled in a dual credit class (Chem2H, IDEA, US Gov/AP Gov, Marketing) or a senior enrolled in one semester classes (PE4) must still take their exam in these classes.
- You are a senior who has an "F" in any class for Quarter 3 or Quarter 4.

PLEASE NOTE: The final semester 2 grade will still be calculated as... quarter 3: 40%, quarter 4: 40% and the final exam: 20%.

You have a **choice** to take or not to take the exam if...

- You are a senior who has earned a passing grade (D- or better) at the end of BOTH quarter 3 and quarter 4.

PLEASE NOTE: If the student chooses not to take the final exam, their final semester 2 grade will be calculated as... quarter 3: 50% and quarter 4: 50%.

Guidelines for choosing to take the final exam:

- *Any student who has a passing grade (A to D-) in **both** quarter 3 & 4 may still opt to take the final exam but must notify their teacher by email that they **WANT** to take the exam. Emails must be received no later than **Friday, May 7**. **Do NOT email your teacher if you are NOT choosing to take the exam.***

General Information on Final Exams

- Please be aware that there will be NO make-ups for semester exams. They must be taken at the date and time scheduled.
- The Parent/Student Grades Portal will be closed at 4:00 pm on Wednesday, May 19 so final grades can be calculated.
