TICKET SALES

- *How much do tickets cost?* \$60.00 per person if you worked concessions this year; \$125.00 per person if you did not.
- When are Ticket Sales? April 3 9 during the lunch periods. AVOID THE RUSH PURCHASE EARLY! Due to deadlines with the venue, tickets cannot be sold after April 9th. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- How are tables assigned? Tables seat 10 individuals. Please gather your group and have the
 entire PROM TICKET TABLE FORM completed and turned in at time of ticket purchase. One
 designated student should collect all of the money/info for the table and turn it in. All students
 listed on the table form MUST purchase tickets at the same time. Also, please choose a
 preferred table from the BOULDER RIDGE FLOOR PLAN. Table selections are first-come, first
 served.
- What are they serving for the meal? Students will have their choice of Grecian Roasted Chicken or Vegan Stir-Fry. Please note this on your Table Form.
- *Emergency Contact Info?* In the event of an emergency, it is imperative that we contact a parent/guardian by phone. Please include this information on the PROM TICKET TABLE Form.
- Can I bring a date that does not attend Marian? Yes. You must provide a completed <u>DATE</u>
 <u>APPLICATION</u>. when you are purchasing prom tickets. Please note: all non-Marian dates must be of the opposite gender as the Marian student. No exceptions will be made for this dance.



RULES & REGULATIONS

Failure to comply with the regulations listed below will result in the forfeiture of the cost of the tickets. There will be no refunds.

Transportation To/From Event:

- ALL students and guests attending the Prom will ride the buses to and from the venue. No
 exceptions will be made to this.
- No backpacks or large bags/purses will be allowed on the buses or at Prom. If students have
 after-prom events, please plan for backpacks, pillows, etc. so the Prom Chaperones can make
 sure all students have safely left the Marian parking lot once the bus drops off at school after
 prom.

Expected Behavior & Attire:

- Although we recognize that fashion trends do not always make it easy, please display modesty in your dress. If you have any questions, please contact either Mr. Winkelman or Mr. Williams.
- Students will show respect and abide by the requests of any adult chaperones who will be supervising Prom. This respect is expected on the bus as well as at the Prom location.
- Once at the venue, the students and their guests must remain in the assigned area. Students who leave the assigned areas will be suspended from school.
- Guests are subject to the same regulations as Marian Students. The Marian student is responsible for any misconduct by his/her date.
- All Marian students have, in a proactive manner, been informed as to what the school's position
 is regarding appropriate dancing. "Sexually Explicit Dancing" will not be tolerated at any dances
 sponsored by Marian Central. Any students who choose not to abide by Marian's expectations
 will be removed from the dance floor, their parents will be contacted and be required to pick up
 their student immediately.
 - a. Inappropriate touching of any type is not allowed.
 - b. Dancing partners must face one another when dancing.
 - c. Hands around their partner's waist/neck are acceptable.
 - d. No body surfing/lifting, gyrating with sexual connotation, or straddling is permitted.



Alcohol/Tobacco/Drug Policy

- Prom 2025 is to be a tobacco/e-cigarette/alcohol/drug free activity. Your cooperation and effort
 in this goal is appreciated and expected. Parents, please talk to your teenagers about having fun
 without the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- As stated in our Student Handbook, Marian Central reserves the right to require a student to
 undergo testing for the use of alcohol and/or drugs when a reasonable suspicion of such use
 exists. Failure to comply with testing will result in an immediate phone call to a parent to come
 pick up a student from Prom, in addition to possible disciplinary action up to and including
 expulsion from school. Please see Page 43 of the Student Handbook for more information.
- As is the case with all Marian activities, the possession of, consumption of, or being under the
 influence of alcohol, drugs, or tobacco is prohibited. Students and guests who display any signs
 of being under the influence of alcohol or other drugs before or during Prom will not be
 permitted to attend or remain at Prom. Parents will be notified and must pick up their student.
 Students violating these policies will be subject to the following consequences:
 - a. Suspended for up to five days. These days will be recorded as "unexcused absences."
 - b. Required to enroll in and complete an alcohol/drug assessment program at the family's expense. This program is to be administered by a Marian-approved organization.
 - c. If a senior student, the student will not be allowed to participate in the Senior Cookout.
 - d. Refused participation in all co-curricular activities for the remainder of the school year.
 - e. Dismissal immediately from any government leadership position.
